## MCPS DIPLOMA Device Care

MCPS shall provide computer related technology resources to its students for educational purposes. The goal of providing these resources is to promote educational excellence.

#### Lenovo Laptop Care

- Please do not use food or drink near your Lenovo Laptop.
- Cords, cables, and removable storage devices should be inserted and removed with caution.
- Do not carry your Lenovo Laptop while the screen is open; unless specifically directed by a teacher.
- When not in use, your Lenovo Laptop should be closed and put to sleep to conserve battery life.
- Do not write on, draw on, or place stickers or labels anywhere on your Lenovo Laptop computer or case.
   Removable clings are allowed.
- Do not remove or change the physical structure of the Lenovo Laptop including keys, screen cover, or plastic
  casing. Doing so will void the warranty and the Student and his/her Parents will be responsible for the full repair or
  replacement cost.

•	Do not leave your Le	novo Laptop in a car or unsupervised.
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#### Lenovo Laptop Case

- Please keep your Lenovo Laptop in its protective sleeve when carried.
- Do not place any other objects (folders, books) within the protective sleeve.
- Completely close the lid and wait for it to enter sleep mode before moving it and/or putting it into its protective sleeve.
- Your Lenovo Laptop may be placed in your backpack to be transported as long as it is within its protective sleeve.
   Take caution to not place heavy objects (books, binders, etc.) on top of your Lenovo Laptop.
- Do not grab and squeeze the Lenovo Laptop as this can damage the screen and other components.
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#### Lenovo Laptop Battery

- It is the Student's responsibility to bring your Lenovo Laptop charged, with the cord provided, to school each day. Failure to do so may result in the Student's inability to participate in classroom learning activities.
- Do not use the charging cord in a manner that will cause a tripping hazard.
- Do not let the battery completely drain. Immediately shut down if you are unable to connect to the charger.
- Close the lid on the Lenovo Laptop when it is not in use in order to save battery life and protect the screen.

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### Lenovo Laptop Screen

- Please protect your screen from damage and excessive pressure.
- Do not touch your Lenovo Laptop screen with anything (finger, ink pen, marker, etc.) other than approved computer screen cleaners or approved stylus'.
- A pen or pencil left on the keyboard will crack the screen when the lid is closed.
- Do not lean on the top of the Lenovo Laptop when the lid is closed. Excessive pressure will crack your screen.
- Do not poke the screen.
- Please clean the screen with a soft, dry, anti-static, or microfiber cloth, or with screen cleaner designed specifically for LCD-type screens. Do NOT use cleaning solutions!
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•	In case of theft, vandalism, or criminal acts, an official police report will be filed.  The Student is responsible for maintaining a 100% working Lenovo Laptop at all times. The Student will use reasonable care to ensure that the Lenovo Laptop is not damaged. In the event of damage, the student must report the damage within 1 school day. In the event of negligent damage, Students and/or Parents will be responsible for the cost of the replacement of the Lenovo Laptop. (pi)(Si)
