

MCPS Student Expectations When Remoting into Classes or Meetings (8.14.20)

- Students will log into class or meeting at the designated time to be counted present
- Student cameras and microphones will be on or off as directed by the teacher
- Students will work on assignments when directed by the teacher
- Students will be actively engaged in learning and discussions when appropriate
- Students will be dressed in school appropriate attire
- Students should be in a quiet place at a table or desk ready to learn
- Students will request help or assistance when needed
- Students will notify the teacher of any technology or connectivity concerns

Topics for Teachers to Consider

- Confidentially—camera on the instructor or information being projected
- Time management—maximizing instructional time for all learners
- Lesson structure—designing lessons for both in-person and remote learners
- Content Delivery—Direct instruction, whole group, small group, etc.
- Classroom management—realizing the microphone is always on and the camera is always rolling
- Parent Conferences—schedule them during appropriate times
